

The settlement date is the date the money is debted from your bank account and credited to the Department of Revenue account. Payments cannot be made from a foreign bank account. You must remit payment in the form of a check payable in United States currency. Credit Cards: Payments made on AZTaxes must be completed before 5:00pm Mountain Standard Time (MST) and will be credited to your Department of Revenue account the same day. All liabilities except license fees can be paid with a credit card. Holidays or Weekends When the due date falls on a weekend or Arizona holiday, the payment will be due the next Arizona business day. Fleids marked with * are required.
